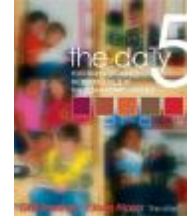


The Daily 5 – Fostering Literacy Independence in the Elementary Classroom

Workshop Description



We are two elementary teachers who love teaching, but felt exhausted from the energy we expended cajoling, disciplining and directing students on a daily basis. We tried many different management systems in our classrooms, including centers and seatwork, but struggled to find anything that could engage students in truly meaningful work. We didn't experience success until we developed the "Daily Five," a system for teaching students to work independently. Based on literacy theories developed by Margaret Mooney and David Pearson, and motivation research by Michael Grinder, the Daily Five has been practiced and refined in our own classrooms and classrooms across the nation for over 10 years. The Daily Five is a series of literacy tasks (reading to self, reading with someone, writing, word work, and listening to reading) which students complete daily while the teacher meets with small groups or confers with individuals.

This presentation will not only explain the philosophy behind the structure, but show participants how to carefully and systematically prepare students to participate in each of the five components. Explicit modeling, practice, reflecting and refining take place during the launching phase, preparing the foundation for a classroom filled with meaningful content instruction tailored to meet the unique needs of each child. In our presentation, we will show key elements of the Daily Five, including:

- *The Research Base for Thoughtful Independent Work
- *Gradual Release of Responsibility Over the First Days and Weeks of the Daily Five
- *Correct/Incorrect Modeling
- *Short Intervals of Repeated Practice
- *Individual Book Boxes with Quality Texts
- *Ways to Redirect Students

We suspect most teachers have a clear understanding of best practices in literacy instruction, and the importance of helping students develop the ability to work independently. Yet we suspect many of the attendees, like us; struggle to find a way to help students work independently on truly challenging and research based literacy tasks. We believe The Daily Five is a system that ensures students can thrive as readers and writers without constant intervention and support from teachers during literacy workshops. Our presentation will include ample time for questions and comments from the audience.
