Use the 10 Steps to Teaching and Learning Independence to launch Listen to Reading:

- 1 Identify what is to be taught: Listen to Reading
- 2 Set a purpose: Create a sense of urgency
  - Helps us improve our fluency
  - Helps us practice Check for understanding and comprehension
  - It is fun
- Identify the behaviors of
  Listen to Reading on
  I-chart.
- 4 Model most-desirable behaviors
- 5 Model least-desirable, then most-desirable behaviors (same student)
- 6 Students check in; teacher places students around the room
- 7 Practice and build stamina
