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

3 simple and powerful
strategies to help you
know what THEY need.

Let's go over what we learned.



Purpose

Powerful strategies exist to help us know what each child needs to move forward. The key is knowing what strategies work and how to employ them in our work with students. This coaching session will uncover 3 simple, yet powerful strategies to get at the heart of knowing what each of your students need.

First: Start by building positive relationships with each student.

Strategy 1: Be Curious

The mind set we possess when finding out what THEY need, is to start from a place of curiosity and wonder.

- I wonder what makes them particularly unique as a reader.
- I wonder what they are really good at doing as a reader.
- I wonder what they know about them as a reader.
- I wonder what they want for them as a reader.
- I wonder what they want from me to help support them as a reader.
- I wonder what they have done before that helped them with their reading.

Strategy 2: Ask Them

This strategy invites students to take ownership of their learning. First ask them, then most importantly, watch and listen.

- Tell me about yourself as a reader.
- What is going well? Why? Show me.
- What have you been working on? Show me.
- What do you want to work on?

We watched and listened as students and teachers discovered what students wanted and needed.

What was your take away, or what did you learn from watching?

Strategy 3: Be Confident

Use your tenacious enthusiasm and confidence to take action and impact learning.

DEVELOP AND REINFORCE YOUR CONFIDENCE.

Each time you walk into a classroom, meet with a student, teach a lesson, talk to a parent and/or colleague:

Lift your head up,



take a deep breath in, . . . exhale,



smile,



and say,

"I've got this!"

BELIEVE IN YOUR ABILITIES.

When you listen and watch you are capable of creating a learning path fueled by student ownership and your teacher insights.

APPROACH EACH ACTION WITH KINDNESS TO YOUR STUDENTS AND YOURSELF.

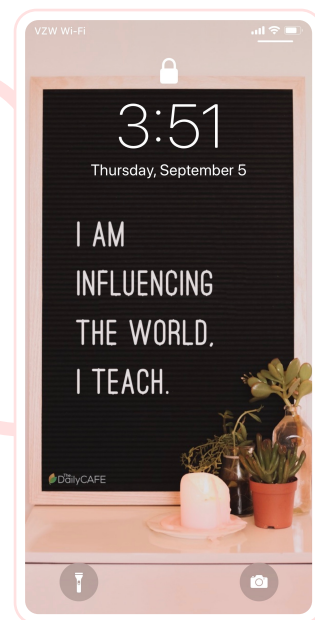
We are all doing the best we can at this moment, based on these circumstances. If at first you don't see growth, try again.
