- Math materials
- Choose what to write about
- Underline words you don't know how to spell, and move on
- What to do when you need help

PHASE 2: LAUNCH

Use the 10 Steps to Teaching and Learning Independence to launch **Math Writing:**

- Identify what is to be taught: Math Writing
- 2 Set a purpose: Create a sense of urgency
 - Helps us get better at math
 - It is fun
- Identify the behaviors of **Math Writing** on I-chart. Sample I-chart:

- Model most-desirable behaviors
- Model least-desirable, then most-desirable behaviors (same student)
- 6 Students check in with **Math Writing**; teacher places students around the room
- Practice and build stamina
- 8 Stay out of the way; when necessary, confer and set behavior goals
- Use a quiet signal—come back to group
- Oroup check-in: "How did it go?" Graph stamina.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Continue building Math Writing stamina until students reach stamina goal.
- With remainder of time in math block, pre-teach and/or review another game or activity and add to the math board.
