### Phase 2: Launch

Use the 10 Steps to Teaching and Learning Independence to launch **Word Work**:

Step 1 Identify what is to be taught: Word Work

Step 2 Set a purpose: Create a sense of urgency

- Help us become better readers and writers
- It is fun
- Step 3 Identify the behaviors of Word Work on I-chart.

Sample I-charts: (see next page)

- Step 4 Model most-desirable behaviors
- Step 5 Model least-desirable, then most-desirable behaviors (same student)
- Step 6 Place students around the room
- Step 7 Practice and build stamina
- Stay out of the way; when necessary, confer and set behavior goals
- Step 9 Use a quiet signal, gather
- Step 10 Group check-in: "How did we do?"
