Earn 1 Graduate Level Professional Development Credit Participating in an Educational Design Live Workshop

Course Description

Live workshop/ Online Seminar: This course offers educators the opportunity to earn one credit for attendance at one Daily 5 workshop or seminar and one CAFE workshop or seminar. A research reflection paper is required for each credit. There is an option for one credit for the Daily 5 workshop OR seminar (not both), one credit for the CAFE workshop OR seminar (not both), and one credit for the Math Daily 3 online seminar.

Credit Information

Upon successful completion of an approved workshop and the accompanying requirements, Upper Iowa University will award one semester hour of graduate level professional development credit. These credits are predominantly used for professional advancement (increase on pay scale or recertification), and are not part of a degree program. It is the student's responsibility to verify approval from appropriate district or college officials before attempting to use these credits to satisfy any degree, state recertification, or school district requirements. Upper Iowa will not assume responsibility if a credit is not accepted due to the location of the university or criteria of credit acceptance. State licensing departments, school districts, and other degree programs vary regarding their criteria for credit acceptance.

Clock Hours - Many states accept regionally accredited two- or four-year college credit at the 100 (freshman) level or above to be used toward maintenance. One semester hour of college credit is the equivalent of 15 clock hours. State licensing departments and school districts vary regarding their criteria for credit acceptance. It is your responsibility to check with your individual state or district.

Course Requirements

For each credit:

- 1. Attend a 2 Sisters workshop or seminar.
- 2. Once you have completed the workshop, complete the appropriate "Getting Started" guide for your workshop. (If you attend both workshops you will need to complete both "Getting Started" guides. Daily 5 and CAFE can be found at http://www.thedailycafe.com/public/2381.cfm. Math Daily 3 can be found at https://www.thedailycafe.com/articles/Math-Daily-3-Quick-Start-Guide. Reflect on your learning and the impact it will have on you in your current position in education. What research was highlighted and what implications does it have for you as a professional? Adhering to the guidelines below, write a 2-3 page reflective essay (one for each workshop attended) about your learning.

Research Reflection Paper Guidelines

- Paper must include a Title Page with your name, address, title of course and course number, workshop or seminar completion date and date sent.
- Use a 12 point font and one inch margins. Staple the paper together. Do not use a report cover.
- Your reflective research paper should include highlights of your learning about Daily 5 and CAFE. What do
 you agree with? What challenges do you face? What research reinforces the philosophy of Daily 5/ CAFE?
- You must reference a minimum of 3 sources, using correct APA format for in-text citations and the bibliography.
- This paper is an individual assignment to be completed by the individual receiving the credit. Group papers will not be accepted.

You will be graded on the accuracy of the above guidelines, and according to the attached rubric.

3. Send in your Educational Design completion certificate, along with the Upper Iowa University registration form, and your research reflection paper. Grades will be entered following UIU's 6 term schedule. Please allow 6 – 8 weeks for grading.

Submitting Report

- A copy of your online course completion participation certificate **must** be included with your report to be accepted for grading.
- Your registration and paper are due (postmarked) **six months** from the end date of the workshop. Extensions are not allowed. **Your paper will not be returned to you**. Grades will be determined according to the rubric. Allow 6 8 weeks for grading. Transcripts may be requested following the link below.

If you wish to receive feedback, include a self-addressed, postage paid envelope with your registration materials.
